Enterprise Mobility Architect at Unwired Revolution

Matt graduated from UCSB in 2006, having earned a degree in Computer Engineering with Honors. While a freshman, he founded Pacific Swell Networks, Inc., an outsourced IT services company, with a business partner in Los Angeles. He continued with Pacific Swell after graduation, building the business to reach revenues of up to 3/4 of a million dollars per year. In 2010, Matt sold off Pacific Swell Networks and joined Unwired Revolution, an enterprise mobility consulting and integrating firm. Since joining, Matt has helped build a mobile device management solution, WorkLink, which helps facilitate iPhones and iPads in the enterprise.
